6. Professional: See Division 100 Rule #12
7. **NOTICE:** All artwork must be original. A piece of work that is a recognizable copy of another artist's work, whether or not published, is not an original, and may be in violation of copyright law. Works determined to be in violation of this provision can be disqualified at any time during the Fair.
